

COMPETITION RULES

"Balance" 2024

Sarajevo, 25.-27. April, 2024.

- Competition "Balance" 2024 is open competition in classical ballet and contemporary dance for all students of elementary and secondary ballet schools and studios from all over the world.

CLASSIC BALLET

- Participants should not be younger than 2017 year of berth. They can apply in categories which are connected with their years of ballet education like it is shown down:

7.	VIIa Category	Students of hospitation
8.	VIIb Category	I i II class of secondary ballet school/studio
9.	VIII Category	III i IV class of secondary ballet school/studio

ELEMENTARY SCHOOL/STUDIO FROM I-IV CATEGORY:

- Competition in those four categories have two parts. In first part students are presenting exercises from ballet class.
- Every elementary school/studio in those four categories are presenting exercises in Center, Allegro (jumps) and point exercises (Point exercises are not for I and II category) which will be set by ballet pedagogy.
- Participant who successfully finish first part, in second/final part participants are showing choreographies which are prepared by their teachers.
- Choreography should be prepared according to child's affinity or original variation.



- Time limits of those choreographies are 1,5 minute for I and II categories, and 2,0 minutes for III and IV categories.
- Competitors should be dressed: camisole leotards in one color with no skirts, white tights, soft shoes and point shoes (for III and IV categories).
- Participants in final part are dancing in their own costumes.

ELEMENTARY SCHOOL/STUDIO FROM V-VI CATEGORIES

- Competition in those categories have two parts. In first part students are presenting exercises from ballet class.
- Students are showing exercises from ballet class in Center, Allegro (jumps) and point exercises which will be set by pallet pedagogy.
- Participant who successfully finish first part, in second/final part participants are showing choreographies which are prepared by their teachers.
- Choreographies should be created according to affinity of student.
- Time limit for second/final part is 2,5 minutes for both categories, or 5 minutes for pas de deux.
- All participants from those categories should have camisole leotards in one color with no skirts, white tights, soft shoes and point shoes.
- Participants in final part are dancing in their own costumes.

SECONDARY SCHOOL/STUDIO FROM VIIa - VIII CATEGORY

- Participants which have finished their ballet education in system of four years, but they are not still in secondary school, they can apply in VIIa category.
- Participants from VIIb category are students from I and II class of secondary school/studio.
- Participants from VIIb category are students from III and IV class of secondary school/studio.
- Competition in those four categories have two parts. In first part students are presenting exercises from ballet class.
- Students are showing exercises from ballet class in Center, Allegro (jumps) and point exercises.
- Exercises is showing ballet teacher.

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- All participants from those categories should have camisole leotards in one color with no skirts, white tights, soft shoes and point shoes.
- Participant who successfully finish first part, in second/final part participants are showing one of variations which are in this document for those categories.
- Time limit for solo variations should not be longer than two minutes and thirty seconds (2:30), and pas de deux not longer than two minutes and forty five seconds (2:45). Exceptions are Adagio and Coda, which should not be longer than six minutes (6:00).
- Participants in final part are dancing in their own costumes.

IMPORTANT INFORMATIONS FOR PARTICIPANTS FROM ALL CATEGORIES

- Exercises could be shown with piano or with music from CD.
- Music from CD should not consist applause and noises. This music should be sanded with application on email address <u>tanzelarija@outlook.com</u>. You should save music with following data: 1. Name of school/studio
 - 2. Category and discipline
 - 3. Name of variation
 - 4. Beginning of variation (on stage or out of stage).
- Participants will be judged as individuals.

SCORING:

- Competition is created on selection principle. Participants who sucesfuly finish first part, can take part in second/final part.
- Judge team is selected by council of Organization Tanzelarija.
- Members of jury are exclusively international ballet teachers and dancers.
- Judge team consist: one president and minimum two members and one honorary member of jury.
- Scoring system consist two elements: technical and artistic.
- Scoring system is made by 100 point system.
- Total score is average of scores given by judges.

Scoring:

- 91-100 points I price
- 81-90 points II price
- 71-80 points III price

61 – 70 points – Accolade

- 0-60 points Participation.
- If student exceeded time limit, Judge team will refuse 5 points from average score.

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- If group or individual student, do not respect dress code, judge team will refuse 5 points.
- Beside those prices, Tanzelarija have special price "Emina Minka Kamberović" which will be chosen by Minka Kamberović, who is honorary member of jury.
- Every participant will receive certificate on the end of competition.

- Every participant will pay fee 30€.
